





*With the clock twenty four hours Theselius and Andreas Roth continue their examination of stripped objects.*

24 hours is made by the same principles as a clock in a swimming pool or a soccer stadium - it is readable in motion, with a kind of acute perception.

Structurally, the clock consists of a chassis that holds parts in place. Instead of making the cover of a box the sides are removed. This reveals the clocks stratification in depth: the glass, hands, face and in the back the clockwork and chassis backing. The framework becomes the product itself.
